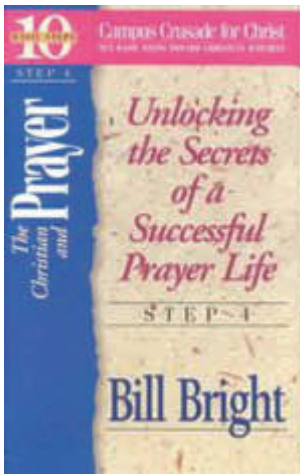


Nooma DVD Series

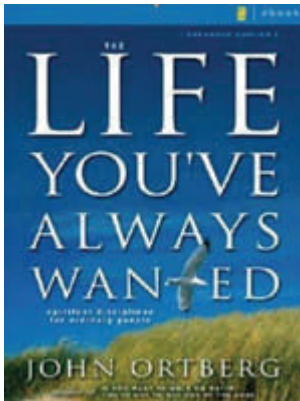

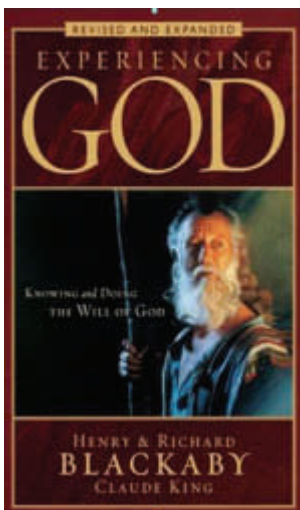

The Life You've Always Wanted

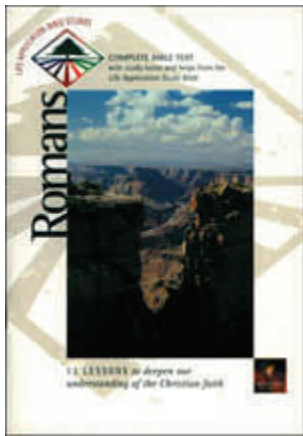

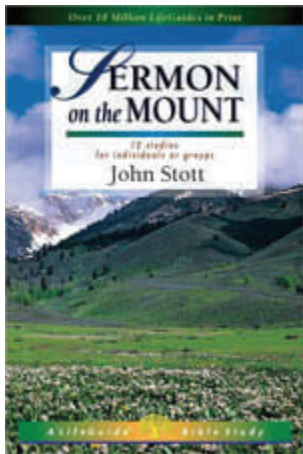
Experiencing God

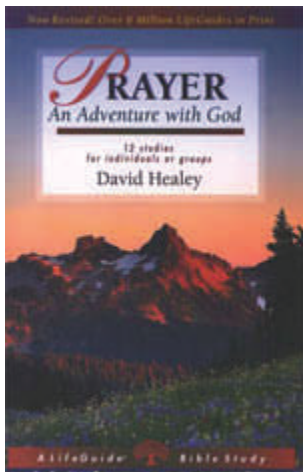

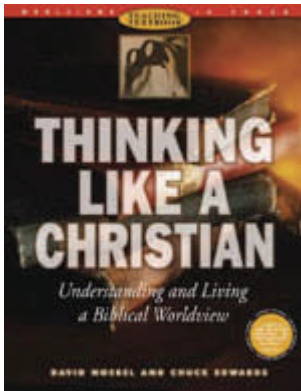
Prayer: An Adventure With God

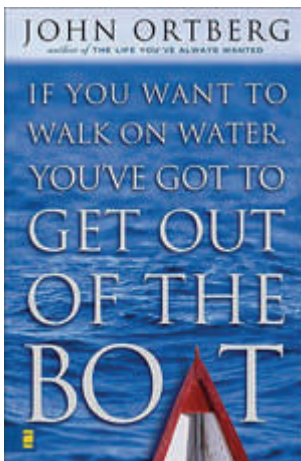
Sharing Your Life Mission Every Day
